IMPORTANT THINGS TO REMEMBER

1. Tuition must be paid in full **before** the first day of camp (\$25 registration fee is not part of \$140).
2. If you do not currently have an extended day blanket bring a beach towel to use at rest time!
3. Bring a full change of clothes (including underwear and socks).
4. Extra water bottle
5. **Sunscreen must be applied before arrival**
6. Please have the children **wear tennis shoes** (for running, biking, hiking, etc.)
